

Student Accounts

Important Information!

- An individual student account is maintained for each band student participant. The account will include any and all money profited or paid by the student.
- Various fundraisers will be available throughout the school year to assist the student to raise money for the annual band trip etc.
- Each fundraiser will have a chairperson(s) along with paperwork to explain the sale, profit potential, and due dates for all orders and money to be turned in.
- When a student participates in a fundraiser, the profit received by the student will not be applied to the student account until the fundraiser is officially closed by the chairperson and the appropriate documentation is turned into the Student Accounts Treasurer.
- All fundraisers will deduct 10% FOR THE BAND BOOSTERS GENERAL FUND.
- All Student Accounts and profits accumulate from year to year. A family account can be requested and only applies to High School Members.

***For example, in the specific case of a family with an incoming freshman and a graduating senior, providing the senior account is considered in good standing, a family account can be created, at your request, at the end of the graduating students' senior year. All family accounts must be siblings living at the same address. Requests for family accounts can be done at the end of Band Camp.*

- If for any reason a student has money left in their account at the end of their senior year June 30th, OR if they are no longer participating in band, the money automatically reverts back to the Band Boosters' General Fund. NO Exceptions.
